

The Leadership Transition Team, along with the Call Committee, has recommended appointing **SHAWN JENNINGS AS OUR PASTOR**, effectively removing the "Assistant" from his title. This recommendation is a testament to Pastor Shawn's dedication, spiritual leadership, and the positive impact he has had on our congregation. By endorsing Pastor Shawn for this role on February 12, the Council is reaffirming its commitment to ensuring stable and continuous pastoral leadership. Consequently, the Call Committee has been asked to halt the search for interim lead pastors and to pivot towards other essential tasks. We announced these exciting changes during the first and second worship services on February 18. Moving forward, a key step will be to hire a Youth Minister/Christian Education Leader to fill the vacancy left by Pastor Shawn's promotion.



Me? Participate in a prison ministry? I'm too shy to even witness to people "like me" – how on earth.... prisoners? But that's exactly what I was called to check out. I think I felt a little like Jonah, Moses, or Ananias --- Not my cup of tea. Run the other way! Sure, it was a piece of what Jesus ordered "Go into the world and preach the Gospel to all creation" (Mk 16:15) (not to mention that thing about "... I was in prison, and you came to visit me..." in Matthew 25). But ME?? Well, after a time, I (too reluctantly) attended a Kairos "closing" ceremony at Toledo Corrections Institution. This ceremony was the conclusion of a 3-1/2 day in-prison Kairos retreat. In the retreat, the inmates newly experienced Jesus' love in the Gospel --and what that means to them. What I saw in the closing ceremony was AMAZING! They spoke of how the Holy Spirit was there ... dwelling in joyful hearts that previously had not known hope. Did I want to be part of that?

# VIES

The Kairos organization in Toledo conducts two 3 ½ day retreats per year at Toledo Corrections, in addition to weekly "prayer and share" sessions. Our next retreat runs March 21-24, with training and team building at a local Church a few Saturdays before the event. If you volunteer, you'll get plenty of training and Spirit-filled team building on those Saturdays before the event. Sometimes, we run short of volunteers, and the result is that we have to reduce the number of inmates we can include. You might feel called to jump right in and volunteer. We need that. Pray about it. If your interest is piqued, but you're more cautious, then you can support this ministry by praying for us and visiting the next "closing" ceremony (like I did). The next one will be IN THE PRISON on the afternoon of March 24. Please put that date on your calendar and call so arrangements can be made for you to be present at the ceremony.
