

**Sermon Notes – “Can You Believe It?”**  
**(May 8, 2022)**

**Sermon Texts:** Act 4:5-12 & Luke 24:36-43

**Introduction:** This is the 4<sup>th</sup> week in a row that we have discussed Luke 24 ... the **first Easter Sunday** ... the day of Jesus' resurrection. *Why spend so much time on this day?* **Because this day changes everything!**

**I. A Busy Day** – *Think of all that has happened this 1<sup>st</sup> Easter Sunday.*

- Women disciples find **the tomb empty** early in the morning. (Luke 24:1-8)
- Women return home, **tell the other disciples**, who can't believe it. (Luke 24:9-11)
- Simon Peter **runs to the tomb, finds it empty** as the women said. (Luke 24:12)
- Jesus **reveals himself to two disciples** on the way to Emmaus. (Luke 24:13-30)
- Jesus **reveals himself to Simon Peter**. (Luke 24:34)
- The disciples gather, discuss **what they've experienced**. (Luke 24:33-35)

**II. Jesus Grand Entrance, Parts I & II** (Luke 24:36-49)

- Jesus' "stood among them" – the **climax** of his resurrection day.
- He has two goals for this visit.
- **Goal 1** – Convince the disciples his **resurrection is real**. (Luke 24:36-43)
- **Goal 2** – Explain (again) **why** he had to **suffer, die & rise**. (Luke 24:44-49)

**III. Today – Let's Talk Part I – Was Jesus Resurrection Real?** (Luke 24:36-43)

- Disciples reaction to seeing Jesus – **surprise, fear, amazement, doubt/unbelief**
- Jesus response:
  - 1) **Words of assurance** – "*Peace be with you; It is I myself*" (vs. 36, 39)
  - 2) **Offers proof he is not "just a ghost"** – "*Touch me and see ...*" (vs. 39)
  - 3) **Does "human" things** – "*Do you have anything here to eat?*" (vs. 41-42)

**Summary:** Jesus' resurrection **only conquers the power of death**, once for all, if Jesus' **whole person** – body and soul – **is raised from the dead**. An apparition or specter would have been **too abstract** and **too surreal** to **create belief** in resurrection and eternal life.

**Faith Challenge** – *Can YOU believe it? Can YOU believe in the resurrection?*
